Minutes October 11, 2018 - Executive Summary

On October 11, 2018, the Executive Board of KIM-I met in Zweibrücken (Landesgruppe Saar-Rhein-Pfalz) on the occasion of the IMP and Annual General Meeting KIM-I.

The Executive Board reports on news in the KIM-I member countries.

There were new elections in France and the new president is Ms. Magali Boulanger.

Norway has elected a new chairman, Mr. Ernst Evensen.

After the FCI Standard was submitted to the FCI via the VDH in 2014, the FCI made a statement for the first time this year. Almost all amendments were accepted. There were only a few notes which were commented on by KIM-Germany and sent back to the FCI. The FCI Standard Commission will deal with this again at its next meeting.

Dietrich Berning presents a proposal for the description of the hunting characteristics of the Kleiner Münsterländer.

The homepage has been re-designed.

The account has continued to develop positively. The account was reviewed by the German auditors. There were no complaints.

Acting President Dietrich Berning, Acting Vice President Cor Bottenheft and Acting Business Manager Jacqueline Mette are proposed by the Executive Board for reelection. The Executive Board proposes Philipp Ita as new Vice President. Atle Johannesen is to receive guest status as representative of the Nordic countries.

The Executive Board proposes that club pins can be purchased. The merit pins in silver and gold will be awarded by the Executive Board.
