Meeting of the Executive Board KIM-I on February 20, 2018

Minutes February 20, 2018 - Executive Summary

On February 20, 2018, the KIM-I Executive Board met for the second time via Skype.

The members of the Executive Board report on news in the member countries.

The FCI Standard Kleine Münsterländer, which was submitted in 2014 through the VDH and forwarded to the FCI, has still not been approved by the FCI.

If KIM-Germany learns that breeders from abroad sell puppies to SMCNA, then the Breeding Commission will block these breeders from access to German stud dogs.

The Große Münsterländer are planning the creation of a world federation. The draft plan is already available. The launch is planned for October 2018.

The financial account has developed positively due to savings in travel expenses through an annual board meeting via Skype.

The Executive Board discussed a change in the test regulations for the IMP-B "Track Work". The motion will be reworded and sent to the member countries in the form of a written vote after the meeting of the Executive Board.

The Executive Board has drafted a code of honor. The background is that an association lives through people who become engaged as volunteers (officials, leaders, ...). The code of honor creates opportunity to say "thank you" by honoring the persons with a merit badge.

In addition, the Executive Board voted to introduce a membership pin for KIM-I, which can then also be sold. The Executive Board supports the proposal and the rules of the code of honor should also be sent to the member countries for approval.

At the Annual General Meeting of KIM-I in autumn 2018, the President, the two Vice Presidents and the Business Manager are up for election.
