Report of foreign mating / semen export

The report of a foreign mating is only made by the competent business office / Head Breed Warden of the country in which the breeder member / the bitch is recognized as a breeding bitch. See excerpt breeding regulations KIM Verband (association).

§17: Stud dog owners / guardians

Foreign matings are to be reported to the Association Breed Warden prior to the mating with a copy of the bitch's approved pedigree of the FCI. The stud dogs must meet the breeding requirements of the German breeding regulations. This also applies to the export of semen. The owner of the foreign bitch must be a member of an association affiliated with KLM-I. Furthermore, the bitch must have a certificate of origin recognized by the FCI and must comply with the FCI standard in the conformation value (at least good) and performance.
