This must be applied for in a timely fashion by the dog handler, enclosing a copy of the pedigree and the test scoresheets, from the national kennel club.

Please remember to apply for the utility dog certificate in good time, as it must be submitted with the registration documents.

Entry Deadline: September 10, 2025

Entry Fee for the Breed Show:

The entry fee is included in the Lönssuche entry fee.

Breed Show Evaluation:

The evaluation is conducted according to the currently valid Breed Show Regulations of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e.V. (ZschO-KLM).

Class divisions:

The closing date is the day before the Breed Show.

Puppy class: Dogs that are 6 months, but not yet 9 months old.

Youth class: Dogs that are 9 months, but not yet 15 months old.

Utility dog class: Dogs that are 15 months and older, with a passed HZP or VGP/VPS.

Open class: Dogs that are 15 months and older, without having passed a HZP or VGP/VPS.

Admission requirements:

The Breed Show is open to all KIM registered in the stud book of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e.V. or in one of the foreign stud books recognized by the F.C.I.

Proof of a valid rabies vaccination must be submitted for each dog.
